Council Present: Mayor- Anna LeDuc, Council-Marvin Garding, Betsy Huegelmann, Sharon Briggs, Kyle Cirincione.

Minutes: Minutes read by the clerk Nancy Tome. Marvin approved minutes/Sharon 2nd, All approved.

Claims: Claims discussed in the amount of 12617.50. Kyle approved minutes/ Betsy 2nd. All approved.

Water Project: Paul Montgomery was present and read his report. He stated that we should be expecting an invoice and the next pay package by May's council meeting. RLC restarted construction on March 17. Post Office is being backfilled in preparation for concrete driveway aprons. Uncovered a leaking service line under 2nd. Encountered bedrock at north end of 2nd and on Riverview. Planning to bore under Railroad for service line to 152. Work will continue on Riverview, Orchard and Rosehill, then moving on to Apple, Rockledge and Meadowview, in that order.

Water/Sewer: 2nd St has 3 existing water leaks. 720 Railroad has a curb stop leak. Digital controls are out at the tank sight. Charlei is managing the troubleshooting. Charlei had a meeting with Morrison-Maierle and MDT where they walked the town and discussed the problems with drainage. They are exploring options to manage extra water.
